ORGANIZING YOUR SPACE

If you live in Arnold Hall, Founders Court, Alumni Court, or Gunz Hall, your furniture is allowed to be moved and can be arranged any way you wish. The normal height of your bed is called a "low loft". It is several feet off of the ground and high enough to store things underneath, including a mini-fridge. your bed can also be bunked.

If you wish to "high loft" your bed to make it even higher, please submit a request by emailing studentservices@eureka.edu. Please note that high loft rentals are only available for students who share a room with a roommate.

RESIDENCE HALL CLOSINGS

As you make plans for the school year, please be aware that the residence halls close 3 times throughout the year.

- **Thanksgiving Break**

Close at 5pm on November 20th and re-open at 8am on November 24th

- **Winter Break**

Close at 5pm on December 8th and re-open at 8am on January 14th

- **Spring Break**

Close at 5pm on March 11th and re-open at 8am on March 15th

The residence halls do NOT close for Fall or Easter break. However, there is limited food service at these times. Students needing to stay on campus for athletics, on-campus employment, or any other special circumstance will need to seek approval by completing the appropriate paperwork with the Office of Student Life, before the break begins.
